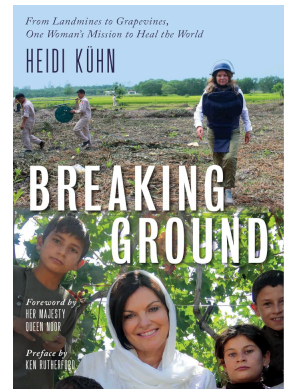
February 4, Tuesday, 10am Gathering for New Members only CM Community Center
