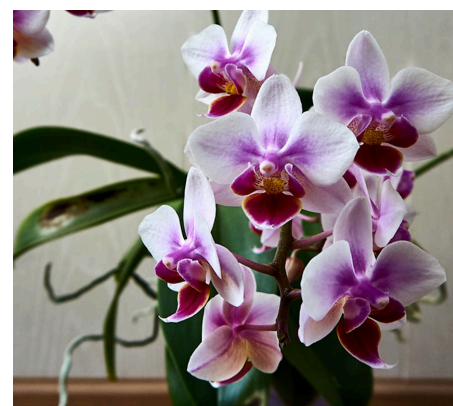


March 4, Tuesday, 10am Phalaenopsis aka Moth Orchid Care CM Community Center

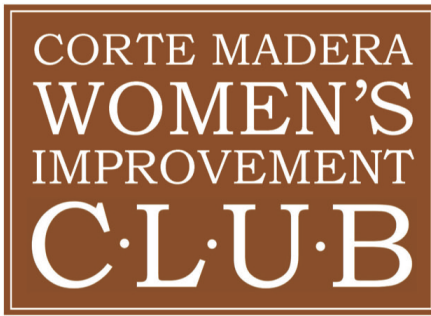
